AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT A RETAIL BUSINESS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT A RETAIL BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-210(a)(1), concerning an application to sell alcoholic beverages at retail, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1)(A) After filing an ~~acceptable~~ application with the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division and the acceptance of the application by the director, the applicant shall ~~cause to be published~~ publish at least one (1) time a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a legal newspaper of general circulation in the city or locality where the business is to be located ~~in which the premises are situated or, if the premises are not in a city, in a newspaper of general circulation for the locality where the business is to be conducted~~, a notice that the applicant has applied for a permit to sell alcoholic beverages at retail.

(B) The newspaper publishing the notice shall have a physical address within the county of the proposed location of the retail business identified in the application.



(C) If the county does not have a newspaper, then the publication shall be placed in a newspaper with the nearest physical address of the location of the retail business identified in the application.
