For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PERMIT CERTAIN PERSONS TO POSSESS A FIREARM
IN A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE THAT SELLS ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION; TO AMEND THE
LAW CONCERNING FIREARMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PERMIT CERTAIN PERSONS TO POSSESS A
FIREARM IN A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE THAT
SELLS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-
PREMISES CONSUMPTION; AND TO AMEND THE
LAW CONCERNING FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-403(21), concerning Class A alcoholic beverage permit violations, is amended to read as follows:

(21)(A) Possession of a weapon on the permitted premises by a person without a possessory or proprietary interest in the permitted premises.

(B) When the permitted premises is a retail liquor store that sells alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption, an employee of the retail liquor store that is licensed to carry a concealed handgun by the state may possess a handgun on the permitted premises if the possession of the handgun is permitted under state law.
