AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR DRIVING ON A
SUSPENDED OR REVOKED DRIVER'S LICENSE WHEN THE
SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION IS THE RESULT OF THE PERSON
DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR DRIVING ON A
SUSPENDED OR REVOKED DRIVER'S LICENSE
WHEN THE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION IS THE
RESULT OF THE PERSON DRIVING WHILE
INTOXICATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-105 is amended to read as follows:

5-65-105. Operation of motor vehicle during period of license
suspension or revocation.

~~Any~~ A person whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle has been
suspended or revoked under ~~a provision of this act~~ this subchapter who
operates a motor vehicle in this state during the period of the suspension or
revocation upon conviction is guilty of an unclassified misdemeanor and shall
be imprisoned for not less than ten (10) days or more than ninety (90) days
and may be assessed a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
