## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING FEES CHARGED FOR NOTARY PUBLIC SERVICES; TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF THE COMMISSIONS OF NOTARIES PUBLICS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING FEES CHARGED FOR NOTARY PUBLIC SERVICES; AND TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF THE COMMISSIONS OF NOTARIES PUBLICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-6-309(a), concerning fees charged by notaries public, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Each notary public in this state ~~shall~~ may charge and collect the following fees:

- (1) For protest and record of same . . . . . \$ 5.00~~;~~
- (2) For each notice of protest . . . . . 5.00~~;~~
- (3) For each certificate and seal . . . . . 5.00~~;~~ and

(4) For actual round-trip mileage, calculated using the federal rate for mileage reimbursement, between the location of service by the notary public and the place of residence or business of the notary public, whichever distance is less.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-14-108(c), concerning the expiration



date of a notary public's commission, is amended to read as follows:

(c) ~~Thirty (30)~~ Sixty (60) calendar days prior to the expiration of a notary public's commission, he or she shall submit to the Secretary of State a new application along with the fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for the renewal of the commission.
