## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 3 OF  
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO MAKE LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS TO TITLE  
3 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING  
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-8-711, concerning the reporting of the use of state funds to oppose or support a ballot measure, is amended to remove an obsolete reference to § 7-9-413, which was repealed by Acts 2013, No. 312, § 6:

3-8-711. Reporting the use of state funds to oppose or support a ballot measure.

Any funds appropriated to any state agency, board, or commission that are expended, ~~as prescribed in § 7-9-413 [repealed]~~, for the purpose of opposing or supporting a local-option ballot question that is submitted or intended to be submitted to a popular vote at an election, whether or not it qualifies for the ballot, shall be reported to the Legislative Council if the amount exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100).

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that:



(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly;

(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly and this act:

(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General Assembly for the purpose of:

(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the Ninety-First General Assembly its full force and effect; and

(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987; and

(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and

(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes to the Arkansas Code of 1987.
