### For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A SURVEY BY A LICENSED SURVEYOR IF  
A NEW RETAIL LIQUOR BUSINESS WILL BE LOCATED WITHIN  
ONE HUNDRED FEET (100') OF THE ONE-THOUSAND-FOOT  
SEPARATION FROM CHURCHES AND SCHOOLHOUSES; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO REQUIRE A SURVEY BY A LICENSED  
SURVEYOR IF A NEW RETAIL LIQUOR BUSINESS  
WILL BE LOCATED NEAR THE STATUTORY  
BOUNDARY FROM CHURCHES AND SCHOOLHOUSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-206, concerning the prohibition of the operation of a retail liquor business near a church or schoolhouse, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(c) If a preliminary inspection by personnel of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division indicates that a proposed location for a retail liquor business appears from any point to be situated between nine hundred feet (900') and one thousand one hundred feet (1,100') of a church or schoolhouse property line, the permit applicant shall submit to the division a survey of the location performed by a licensed surveyor before a permit is issued for the retail liquor business.
