### For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION, AMENDMENT 98,  
ALSO KNOWN AS THE "ARKANSAS MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
AMENDMENT OF 2016" REGARDING THE AUTHORITY TO COLLECT  
FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES ADOPTED BY THE  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THE MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
COMMISSION, AND THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL  
DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
ADMINISTRATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
AMENDMENT OF 2016 REGARDING THE AUTHORITY  
TO COLLECT FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE  
RULES ADOPTED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98,  
also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", § 4,  
concerning the administration and enforcement of the rules of the Department  
of Health, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(e) The department may collect fines or fees for any violation of a  
rule adopted under this section.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98,  
also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", § 8,



concerning the licensing of dispensaries and cultivation facilities, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(p) The commission and the division may collect fines or fees for any violation of a rule adopted under this section.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98, also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", § 9, concerning the registration and certification of cultivation facility agents and dispensary agents, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(j) The division may collect fines or fees for any violation of a rule adopted under this section.
