TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS REGARDING
TRAINING AND INSTRUCTION REQUIRED OF A
NEWLY ELECTED SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-629(a)(1)(B), concerning school board member training and instruction requirements, is amended to read as follows:

(B)(i) A member of a school district board of directors elected for an initial or noncontinuous term shall obtain+

~~(i)~~ ~~no~~ no less than nine (9) hours of training and instruction by December 31 of the calendar year following the year in which the member is elected; ~~and.~~

(ii) The hours of training or instruction required under subdivision ~~(a)(3)(B)~~ (a)(1)(B)(i) of this section ~~within the first fifteen (15) months of service on the board of directors~~ shall include training or instruction on how to read and interpret an audit report under subdivision (a)(3)(A)(iii) of this section.
