AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF
A "TOW BUSINESS"; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE
DEFINITION OF A "TOW BUSINESS".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-50-1202, concerning the definitions used in the subchapter regarding the removal or immobilization of unattended or abandoned vehicles, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(15) "Tow business" or "towing business" means a corporation or a business entity with an alternate DBA name, filed with the Secretary of State and regulated by the board to be used exclusively for the operation of a tow facility, vehicle immobilization company, or a storage facility, including without limitation a business that:

(A) Dispatches tow vehicles for nonconsent or consent towing and repossession;

(B) Stores vehicles; and

(C) Conducts business with the general public;
