BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-95-407 is repealed.

~~17-95-407. Recording of certificate.~~

~~Before practicing medicine, every person receiving a certificate from the Arkansas State Medical Board shall have the certificate recorded in the office of the county clerk where he or she proposes to practice. When the person moves to another county for the purpose of continuing the practice of medicine, he or she shall file for record with the county clerk of the county to which he or she moves a certified copy of his or her certificate.~~
