AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO ARKANSAS LAW  
CONCERNING THE ACCEPTANCE OF CERTAIN FEDERAL BENEFITS  
PROMOTING VOCATIONAL EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO ARKANSAS  
LAW CONCERNING THE ACCEPTANCE OF CERTAIN  
FEDERAL BENEFITS PROMOTING VOCATIONAL  
EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-51-211 is amended to read as follows:

6-51-211. Acceptance of certain federal benefits promoting vocational education.

(a) The State of Arkansas accepts the benefits of ~~an~~ a federal act passed by the United States Congress entitled, ~~"An Act to provide for the promotion of vocational education; to provide for cooperation with the states in the promotion of such education in agriculture and the trades and industries; to provide for cooperation with the states in the preparation of teachers of vocational subjects; and to appropriate money and regulate its expenditure," approved by the President on February 23, 1917~~ "Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006", as amended, and in effect January 1, 2021.

(b) The state agrees to observe and to comply with all the



requirements of the federal act.
