AN ACT PROHIBITING A PERSON REQUIRED TO REGISTER AS A
SEX OFFENDER FROM ENTERING CERTAIN LOCATIONS DESIGNED
FOR PUBLIC AQUATIC ACTIVITIES; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-133 is amended to read as follows:

5-14-133. Registered offender prohibited from entering a water park owned or operated by a local government.

(a) As used in this section, "water park" means a recreational aquatic facility that has among its features a swimming pool, wave pool, splash pad, water slide, or other area dedicated to aquatic activities for children and is open to the general public.

(b) It is unlawful for a person who is required to register under the Sex Offender Registration Act of 1997, § 12-12-901 et seq., and who has been assessed as a Level 3 or Level 4 offender to knowingly enter a water park owned or operated by a local government.

(c) A violation of this section is a Class D felony.
