AN ACT TO MODIFY THE LAW CONCERNING THE ELECTRONIC
RECORDING COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO MODIFY THE LAW CONCERNING
THE ELECTRONIC RECORDING COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-2-305(a), concerning the administration and standards of the Electronic Recording Commission, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) An Electronic Recording Commission consisting of eleven (11) members appointed by the Governor is created to adopt standards to implement this subchapter.

(2) A majority of the members of the commission ~~must~~ shall be county recorders.

(3) A member of the commission ~~must be an active state legislator~~ shall be from the banking, title, or real estate industry.

(4) A member of the commission shall serve a term of ~~two (2)~~ four (4) years.

(5) The terms of the current commission members ~~on July 31, 2009,~~ shall expire on ~~September 1, 2009~~ December 31, 2021.

(6) Each member of the commission may receive expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
