AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE REFUND OF
LOCAL SALES AND USE TAXES BY THE OFFICE OF THE
TREASURER OF STATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE
30, 2023; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF
STATE - REFUND OF LOCAL TAXES
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2022-2023 FISCAL
YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CITY SHARE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the Local Sales and Use Tax Trust Fund, for refunding each city's share of local sales and use taxes assessed by authority of Arkansas Code 26-75-307 by the Office of the Treasurer of State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the following:

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - COUNTY SHARE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the Local Sales and Use Tax Trust Fund, for refunding each county's share of local sales and



use taxes as assessed by authority of Arkansas Code 26-74-307 by the Office of the Treasurer of State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2022.
