AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE STATUS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY
LEASED BY GOVERNMENTAL BODIES FOR LICENSURE PURPOSES;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO CLARIFY THE STATUS OF PERSONAL
PROPERTY LEASE BY GOVERNMENTAL BODIES FOR
LICENSURE PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-302, concerning applications by a county judge for a special license plate, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(c) A motor vehicle that is leased for a period of twelve (12) months or more qualifies as property of the county under subdivision (b)(2) of this section and may display a special license plate.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-24-304, concerning applications of cities and incorporated towns for special license plates, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(c) A motor vehicle that is leased by a city or incorporated town for a period of twelve (12) months or more qualifies as property of the city or incorporated town under subdivision (b)(2) of this section and may display a special license plate.



SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-24-305(a), concerning the validity of a special license plate, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A special license plate issued under this subchapter shall be valid for as long as the motor vehicle to which the plate is attached is:

(1) Owned or leased by the county, city, incorporated town, county quorum court member, or other public entity; and

(2) Used exclusively in the business of the county, city, incorporated town, or other public entity.
