AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE TERMINATION OF
PAROLE FOR A PERSON WHO WAS A MINOR WHEN HE OR SHE
COMMITTED AN OFFENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE
TERMINATION OF PAROLE FOR A PERSON WHO
WAS A MINOR WHEN HE OR SHE COMMITTED AN
OFFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-93-622(a), concerning restoration of rights and termination of parole for minors, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The Parole Board may discharge a person from parole if:

(1) The person:

(A) *Was released on parole under § 16-93-621 or any provision of this Chapter in which the person's parole term exceeds five (5) years, for having committed an offense as a minor; and*

(B) Has served at least five (5) years on parole without a violation; and

(2) The prosecuting attorney in the county where the person was originally convicted has consented to the discharge of the person from parole.
