TO REDUCE THE LICENSE APPLICATION
DEADLINE FOR APPLICANTS TO PRACTICE
CHIROPRACTIC IN THIS STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-81-304(a)(4), concerning applications for a license to practice chiropractic, is amended to read as follows:

(4) The application shall be filed with the director not less than ~~forty-five (45)~~ thirty (30) days before the next regular meeting of the board.
