AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 4 OF
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL
LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 4
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING BUSINESS
AND COMMERCIAL LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 4-56-107(d)(4)(A), concerning digital currency, is reenacted to ratify the decision by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission to change "does not require" to "does not prohibit" and "from compliance with" to "from complying with" in order to correct a grammatical error.

(4)(A) This section does not prohibit a financial institution, or an officer, employee, or agent of a financial institution, from complying with the Right to Financial Privacy Act of 1978, Pub. L. No. 95-630, the Bank Secrecy Act, Pub. L. No. 91-508, or Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council regulations, including without limitation currency transaction reports and suspicious activity reports.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that:

(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-



Fifth General Assembly;

(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the regular session of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly and this act:

(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General Assembly for the purposes of:

(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the Ninety-Fifth General Assembly its full force and effect; and

(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987; and

(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and

(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes to the Arkansas Code of 1987.
