### For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF HUMAN  
TRAFFICKING; TO REQUIRE THE DISPLAY OF INFORMATION  
ABOUT THE NATIONAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING HOTLINE; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF HUMAN  
TRAFFICKING; AND TO REQUIRE THE DISPLAY  
OF INFORMATION ABOUT THE NATIONAL HUMAN  
TRAFFICKING HOTLINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-19-102(a), concerning establishments that are required to post information about the National Human Trafficking Hotline, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The following establishments shall post *in restrooms and in a conspicuous* place near the entrance of the establishment, or where posters and notices of this type customarily are posted, a poster described in subsection (b) of this section measuring at least eight and one-half inches by eleven inches (8½" x 11") in size:

- (1) A hotel, motel, or other establishment that has been cited as a public nuisance for prostitution under § 20-27-401;
- (2) A strip club or other sexually oriented business;
- (3) *A private club that has a liquor permit for on-premises consumption and does not hold itself out to be a food service establishment;*
- (4) *An airport;*



- (5) A train station that serves passengers;
- (6) A bus station;
- (7) A privately owned and operated facility that provides *food, fuel, shower or other sanitary facilities, and overnight parking; and*
- ~~(8) An abortion facility;~~
- (8) A nail salon or massage business licensed by the Department of Health.
