" SECTION 38. APPROPRIATIONS - SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division, to be payable from the Public School Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - General Education Division - School for Mathematics and Sciences which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act 375 of 1995, the following:

SECTION 40. APPROPRIATIONS - SCHOOL DISTRICT MANAGEMENT AND STATEWIDE DATA COLLECTION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division, to be payable from the Department of Education Fund Account, for payment on the loan received from the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, the sum of \$7, 941,403 in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 and \$2,900,293 in the Fiscal year ending June 30, 1999.

SECTION 41. FUNDING TRANSFER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of ten million eight hundred forty one thousand six hundred ninety seven dollars (\$10,841,697) or so much thereof as is required from time to time from the Economic Development of Arkansas Fund the Department of Education Fund Account to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein for payment on the loan received from the Teacher Retirement System. The fund transfer authorized by this section shall be repaid to the Economic Development of Arkansas Fund from the Public School Fund by June 30, 1999."

by striking Section 43 (Emergency Clause) of the bill in its entirety and substituting therefor:

"SECTION 43. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly, that the appropriation and money provided in herein for the School for Mathematics and Sciences, College Station Community Center (Section 31) and the ability for the Department of Higher Education to carry forward balances (Section 30) must be made available during the current fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, Sections 38 and 39 of this Act (Math and Science Supplemental Appropriation and Funding), Section 30 (Higher Education Carryforward) and Section 31 (College Station Community Center) shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, those sections shall become effective on the expiration date of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, those section shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. The remaining sections of this Act shall become effective from and after July 1, 1997."
