Amendment No. _____ to SENATE Bill No. 126

Amend SENATE Bill No. 126 as engrossed 3/31/97
by

inserting the following new sections immediately following Section 29:

"SECTION 30. From the appropriation and funding provided by Item 10 of Section 1 of Act 411 of 1997 for the provision of disaster assistance to Pulaski County, one half shall be used to rebuild the College Station Community Center in Pulaski County.

SECTION 31. Institutions of higher education are authorized to make a monthly contribution to partially defray the cost of life and health insurance for each employee of the institution. Institutions of higher education that do not participate in the plan provided by the Arkansas State Employee and Public School Personnel Board pursuant to Arkansas Code 21-5-401 et seq. shall not be subject to a maximum contribution limit.

SECTION 32. REGULAR SALARIES - CAPITOL ZONING DISTRICT COMMISSION.
There is hereby established for the Capitol Zoning District Commission for the 1997-99 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. SECTION 34. Effective July 1, 1997, the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration, as Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, shall transfer all authority and responsibility of Arkansas State Building Services and the Director of State Building Services with respect to the Capitol Zoning District Commission to the Capitol Zoning District Commission and to the Director of the Commission. The Commission and its staff shall be a separate and distinct agency of government.

SECTION 35. Arkansas Code 22-3-303(c) is amended to read as follows:

(c) The Director of the ~~State Building Services~~ Capitol Zoning District Commission shall serve as the disbursing officer for the Capitol Zoning District Commission.

SECTION 36. Arkansas Code 22-3-202(e)(1) is amended to read as

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follows:

~~_(1) The Director of Arkansas State Building Services shall have the authority to hire the Capitol Zoning District Commission is authorized to employ a director and professional such other staff of the Capitol Zoning District Commission. In hiring a Director of the Capitol Zoning District Commission, the Director of Arkansas State Building Services shall seek the advice of the Capitol Zoning District Commission. as the Commission deems appropriate and within legislative appropriation. "~~

AND

by appropriately renumbering subsequent sections of the bill;

AND

by striking the emergency clause in its entirety and substituting the following:

"SECTION 42. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly that the moneys provided in Section 30 herein for rebuilding the College Station Community Center must be made available during the current fiscal year. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, Section 30 of this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, Section 30 shall become

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effective on the expiration date of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, Section 30 shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. The remaining sections of this Act shall become effective from and after July 1, 1997."

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
