

SENATE AMENDMENT 1 TO SB133.

deleting SECTIONS 1 and 2 and substituting therefor the following:

"SECTION 1. (a) When any juvenile departs, without authorization, from a youth services center or other facility operated by the Division of Youth Services for the care of delinquent juveniles, if the departure creates a substantial risk to the general public, the Director of the Division of Youth Services may release, at the director s discretion, the name, age, and description of the juvenile and any other pertinent information the director deems necessary to aid in the apprehension of the juvenile.

(b) When any juvenile departs, without authorization, from the State Hospital or any other facility to which the juvenile has been involuntarily committed by the state for the testing or treatment of mental illness, if the departure creates a substantial risk to the general public, the Director of the Division of Mental Health Services of the facility may release, at the director s discretion, the name, age, and description of the juvenile and any other pertinent information the director deems necessary to aid in the apprehension of the juvenile."
