Amendment No. _____ to SENATE Bill No. 159

Amend SENATE Bill No. 159 as engrossed 3/13/97
by

inserting two additional sections immediately following Section 60 to read as follows:

"SECTION 61. Arkansas Code 15-12-101(a)(2)(B) is amended to read as follows:

"(B) A member of the Senate, who shall be appointed by the ~~Senate Committee on Committees~~ Present Pro Tempore of the Senate. This member shall serve until the next-following regular session of the General Assembly, at which time a successor member shall be appointed."

SECTION 62. On the effective date of this act the term of office of the current Senate member of the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council shall expire and the Present Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint the Senate member to the council pursuant to Arkansas Code 15-12-101(a)(2)(B).";

AND

by appropriately renumbering the subsequent sections of the bill;

AND

by inserting "(a)" on line 31 on page 29 immediately preceding "It";

AND

by deleting "and this" from line 3 on page 30 and substituting "and Sections 1 through 60 of this";

Amend SENATE Bill No. 159 as engrossed 3/13/97
by

by deleting line 5 on page 30 and substituting therefor the following:

"safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.

(b) It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Present Pro Tempore of the Senate instead of the Senate Committee on Committees should have the authority to appoint the Senate member to the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council; and that authority should be granted immediately; and unless this emergency clause is adopted the authority will not be granted until ninety (90) days after the adjournment of this session. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and Sections 61 and 62 of this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, Sections 61 and 62 shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, Sections 61 and 62 shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto."
