

**SENATE AMENDMENT 1 TO sb304.**

deleting lines 28, 29, and 30 on page 1 and substituting therefor the following:

"extends child support after such circumstances. This section shall not prohibit the court, prior to automatic termination of child support under this section, from ordering child support to a date beyond the automatic termination date. If child support has automatically terminated under this subsection the court may reinstate child support for a period not to exceed one (1) year if the court determines that:

(A) After the divorce decree, the child failed, at least once, to be promoted in school from one (1) grade to another; or

(B) During the final year of child support before automatic termination the child suffered a severe injury or was diagnosed with a severe illness."
