

SENATE AMENDMENT 2 TO sb323.

inserting on line 35 of page 1 between the word "age" and the semicolon (;) the new language ", and a learners license to any person who is at least fourteen (14) years of age";

AND

by inserting on line 4 of page 3 between the word "age" and the period (.) the new language "and the learners license issued to persons who are less than sixteen (16) years of age";

AND

by overstriking on line 20 of page 4 the period (.) at the end of the line and by inserting after the period (.) the new language "; and";

AND

by inserting on line 22 of page 4 between the word "for" and the word "an" the new language "a learners license or";

AND

by inserting on line 26 of page 4 between the word "applicant" and the word "that" the new language "of a learners license";

AND

by deleting on lines 28 and 29 of page 4 the language "from driving between the hours of 12:30 A.M. and 5:30 A.M., unless" and substituting therefor the new words "to driving only when";

AND

by deleting on line 30 of page 4 the period (.) and substituting therefor the new language and a new subdivision (6) as follows: "; and

(6) An acknowledgement signed by the applicant for an intermediate license that all passengers riding in his motor vehicle shall wear seat belts at all times and that he is

restricted from driving between the hours of 12:30 A.M. and 5:30 A.M., unless accompanied by a driver over the age of twenty-one (21) years old."

AND

by inserting on line 23 of page 5 between the word "or" and the word "intermediate" the new language "learners license or";

AND

by inserting on lines 26 of page 5 between the comma (,) and the article "an" the new language "a learners license,";

AND

by removing on line 18 of page 6 the overstriking from the article "a" and after it inserting the new language "learners license or";

AND

by inserting on lines 20 of page 7 between the word "for" and the article "an" the new language "a learners license and";

AND

by inserting on line 9 of page 8 between the language "(\$6.00)" and the semicolon (;) the new language ", and a learners Class D license to each applicant between fourteen (14) and sixteen (16) years of age, for a period of up to two (2) years, upon payment of six dollars (\$6.00)";

AND

by inserting on line 36 of page 9 between the word "Each" and the word "intermediate" the new language "learner's license and"

AND

by removing on line 21 of page 10 the overstriking from the language "at least fourteen (14)";

AND

by deleting on lines 21 and 22 of page 10 the language "within six (6) months of becoming sixteen (16)";

AND

by inserting on line 14 of page 11 between the word "licenses" and the word "and" the new language ", learners licenses,";

AND

by removing on line 22 of page 11 the overstriking from the number in parentheses "(1)";

AND

by removing on line 24 of page 11 the overstriking from the number in parentheses "(2)";

AND

by inserting on line 27 of page 11 after the overstricken period (→) the new language "The office may, upon showing of need, waive any age restriction set forth in this chapter.";

AND

by inserting on line 6 of page 12 after the period (.) at the end of the line a new subsection (f) as follows:

"(f) The office shall have authority to issue a restricted driver license to those persons under sixteen (16) years of age called a learners license. The learners license shall be issued only to an applicant with a valid instruction permit who is at least fourteen (14) years of age, who has remained free of any accidents and convictions for any traffic law violations in the last six (6) months, and who meets all other licensing examinations requirements of this chapter. The driver with a learners license shall operate the motor vehicle on the public streets and highways only when:

(1) all passengers in the vehicle are wearing their seat belts at all times;

and

(2) he is being accompanied by a driver over the age of twenty-one (21) years

old.";

AND

by deleting on line 7 of page 12 the letter in parentheses "f" and substituting therefor the letter "g";

AND

by inserting on line 10 of page 12 between the word "permit" and the word "who" the new language "or a learners license";

AND

by inserting on line 24 of page 12 between the word "license" and the comma (,) the new language "and the learners license";

AND

by inserting on line 27 of page 12 after the period (.) at the end of the line the new sentences as follow: "A learners license shall be issued for no more than a two (2) year period and shall expire upon the driver reaching sixteen (16) years of age. Any person sixteen (16) years of age may apply for an intermediate driver license provided their driving record is accident and conviction free for the most recent six (6) month period.".
