

SENATE AMENDMENT 4 TO SB393.

deleting "provide" on line 17 of page 3 and substituting "be provided"

AND

by inserting on line 22 of page 4 a new subdivision in Section 3 to read as follows:

"(14) "Previous year" means the school year immediately preceding the school year in which funds are allocated."

AND

by appropriately renumbering subsequent subdivisions in Section 3

AND

by deleting lines 16 through 19 of page 9 in their entirety and substituting the following:

"(B) The State Department of Education shall certify, to any affected county treasurer, the local school district identified as having an excess and the amount calculated in subdivision (2) (A) of this subsection by August 1 of each school year."

AND

by deleting lines 20 through 23 of page 9 in their entirety

AND

by deleting lines 24 through 28 of page 9 in their entirety and substituting the following:

"(C) Any county treasurer receiving certification from the State Department of Education under subdivision (2) (B) of this subsection shall remit the amount certified to the State Treasury for the credit of the Public School Fund and redistribute the difference between the net revenues from the uniform rate of tax and the amount certified to the affected local school district."

AND

by deleting "1997-98" on line 29 of page 9 and substituting "1998-99"

AND

by deleting lines 34 through 36 of page 9 in their entirety and substituting the following:

"(B) The State Department of Education shall certify, to any affected county treasurer, the local school district identified as having an excess and the amount calculated in subdivision (3)(A) of this subsection by August 1 of each school year."

AND

by deleting lines 1 through 10 of page 10 in their entirety and substituting the following:

"(C) Any county treasurer receiving certification from the State Department of Education under subdivision (3)(B) of this subsection shall remit the amount certified to the State Treasury for the credit of the Public School Fund and redistribute the difference between the net revenues from the uniform rate of tax and the amount certified to the affected local school district."

AND

by striking the language "and the number of votes cast for each millage" on line 14 of page
