There is hereby appropriated, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for paying per diem, expenses, and mileage to members of the General Assembly attending regular and special meetings and other committee related activities of the Ad Interim Committees of the Arkansas General Assembly which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Item (01) of Section 5 of Act 1312 of 1995, the following:

by striking line 26 on page 12 in its entirety and substituting therefor:

"safety Section 9 of this act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, Section 9 shall become effective on the
