

## SENATE AMENDMENT 2 TO sb542.

deleting line 24 on page 1 and substituting therefor the following:

"five thousand (\$5,000) barrels per year, and to store any"

AND

by deleting "ten thousand (10,000)" on line 21 of page 2 and substituting therefor "five thousand (5,000)"

AND

by adding the following new section on line 3 of page 3 to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 3-5-1205 is amended to read as follows:

3-5-1205. Fees and taxes.

A microbrewery-restaurant licensee shall:

(1) Pay any applicable city or county license or permit fees and barrelage or taxes and shall pay a state licensing fee to the Board of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) per year to manufacture and sell its beer and malt beverages for consumption both on and off the premises and to sell any other beer and malt beverages purchased from a licensed wholesaler for consumption on the premises;

(2) Measure beer and malt beverages manufactured by the microbrewery, and otherwise comply with applicable regulations respecting excise and enforcement tax determination of such beer and malt beverages, and pay any applicable bond or deposit and the amount of the state excise tax and enforcement tax to this state, as required by §§ 3-7-104 and 3-7-111.

(3) Pay a state permit fee to the Board of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per year for the rights and privileges provided by the distribution permit granted as per § 3-5-1204(b). "

AND

by appropriately renumbering the subsequent sections of the bill
