

SENATE AMENDMENT 2 TO sb662.

inserting the word "it" on line 7 of page 2 between the words "that" and "is";

AND

by deleting lines 21 through 23 on page 2 and substituting therefor the following:

"collection system or sewage treatment plant outside the corporate limits of the municipality shall address criteria including, but not limited to, physical possibility and cost of construction or maintenance. However, cost savings associated with placement of a sewage collection system or sewage treatment plant outside the corporate limits of a municipality shall not be considered in the determination of feasibility if the cost savings is less than twenty percent (20%) of the estimated total project cost. The determination of feasibility shall";

AND

by deleting on line 2 of page 3 the word "my" and substituting therefor the word "may";

AND

by inserting on line 35 of page 3 a section to read as follows:

"SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly that the statutory authority granted municipalities to condemn property outside its corporate limits for a sewage collection system or sewage treatment plant causes a severe hardship on unincorporated communities and that this Act should given effect immediately to alleviate such a hardship as mentioned above. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto."
