

HOUSE AMENDMENT 5 TO hb1610.

deleting lines 24 through 28 on page 2 and substituting "fifty dollars (\$50) for each violation."

AND

by deleting lines 2 through 4 on page 3

AND

by deleting "employee shall" from line 9 on page 3 and substituting "employee and the owner shall"

AND

by deleting "employee shall" from line 14 on page 3 and substituting "employee and the proprietor shall"

AND

by deleting "employee shall" from line 16 on page 3 and substituting "employee and his or her employer shall"

AND

by inserting an additional section immediately following Section 9 to read as follows:

"SECTION 10. Nonpreemption. Nothing in this act nor in Arkansas Code 5-27-227 shall be construed or interpreted so as to preempt or in any other manner qualify or limit the enactment and enforcement of any other federal, state, county, municipal or other local regulation of smoking or of the manufacture, sale, storage or distribution of tobacco products. Nothing in this act nor in Arkansas Code 5-27-227 shall be construed or interpreted so as to preempt or otherwise limit any legal or equitable claims or causes of action brought under the common law or any federal or state statutes."

AND

by appropriately renumbering the subsequent sections of the bill.
