

## SENATE AMENDMENT 1 TO SB146.

deleting lines 26 through 28 on page 1 and substituting therefor the following: "of property within the corporate limits of the municipality to designate an agent for service of process. This agent may be required to accept service for any civil action and for service of any action of the municipality brought to enforce against the owner its environmental, safety, fire, building,"

and

by deleting lines 33 and 34 on page 1 and substituting therefor the following: "owner is available for lawful service of process within the state."

and

by deleting from line 1 on page 2 the following: "and compliance with municipal codes"

and

by deleting from line 8 on page 2 the following: "In addition, the"

and

by deleting "agent" from line 9 on page 2 and substituting therefor the following: "When service is made as herein provided the owner"

and

by deleting from lines 13 and 14 on page 2 the following: "and compliance with municipal codes"

and

by deleting line 17 on page 2 and substituting therefor the following: "to, condemnation and demolition of the property. The costs incurred by the municipality in abating the nuisance shall be recoverable as a civil judgment against the owner of the property in addition to filing and enforcing a lien against the property."

and

by deleting from lines 20 and 21 on page 2 the following: "and compliance with municipal codes"

and

by deleting line 23 on page 2 and substituting therefor the following: "not named and registered with the city clerk within ten (10) days; (2)"

and

by deleting "listed" from line 24 on page 2 and substituting therefor "registered"

and

by deleting from line 25 on page 2 the following: "and compliance with municipal codes"

and

by deleting lines 33 and 34 on page 2 and substituting therefor the following:

"SECTION 7. If the owner or agent for service of process is served but the owner fails within a reasonable period of"

and

inserting on line 3 on page 3 between "nuisance" and the period the following: "and recover its costs therefor."
