

## SENATE AMENDMENT 1 TO sb493.

adding the following on line 6 on page 1:

"By: Representative Hudson"

AND

by deleting line 10 on page 1 and substituting the following:

"\$1.50; TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT THAT VEHICLES BE"

AND

by deleting line 16 on page 1 and substituting the following:

"REGISTRATION FEE BY \$1.50; TO REPEAL THE"

AND

by deleting lines 23-36 on page 1 and line 1 on page 2 and substituting the following:

"SECTION 1. (a) In addition to any fees or taxes charged for vehicle registration the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall, at the time of registration of each vehicle or renewal thereof, collect one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) for the annual validation decal.

(b)(1) The one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) collected by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration pursuant to subsection (a) shall be remitted to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority.

(2) All amounts which are to be remitted to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall be cash funds not subject to appropriation, and shall be used and applied by the authority only as provided in § 22-3-1225. The additional fees charged for vehicle registration and paid to the Authority pursuant to this Act shall not be reduced or otherwise impaired during"

AND

by deleting lines 8 through 20 on page 10 and substituting the following:

"(a) Notwithstanding any provisions of this Act to the contrary, commercial motor vehicles and vehicles transporting passengers, which vehicles are required by federal law or regulation or state law or regulation to be inspected, shall be inspected in accordance with such laws or regulations.

(b) The owner of a vehicle not required to be inspected under any provision set

forth in paragraph (a) of this section which requires a commercial driver license to operate, and which is used for the purposes of transporting passengers to and from school, church or church related activities, child or adult day care facilities, senior citizen facilities, for transporting persons with disabilities or any other vehicle required by federal law to be inspected, shall cause such vehicle to be annually inspected for safety and approved for operation. The vehicle owner shall deliver the vehicle to a vehicle maintenance or repair facility regularly engaged in the business of repairing and maintaining vehicles of the type required to be inspected for safety, and request that the vehicle be inspected to determine if the vehicle is in safe operating condition. the cost of the safety inspection shall be an amount mutually agreed upon between the vehicle owner and the owner or operator of the repair facility prior to performing the inspection."

AND

relettering the remaining subsections of Section 5.
