**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Administration Division supervises, regulates and controls the manufacture, transportation, dispensing, sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in the State of Arkansas. The Division, through the Director and with the approval of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, receives applications for and issues or refuses to issue, suspends and revokes licenses to manufacturers, processors, distributors, wholesalers, retailers and transporters of alcoholic beverages. The Division also promulgates rules and regulations necessary to carry out the intents and purposes of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Acts, and conducts hearings on cancellations, suspensions or revocations of permits and on all applications for private club permits.

**TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET**

The total budget of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Administration Division is \$730,630 the first year and \$740,153 the second year of the biennium.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The budget is funded with 98% general revenues and 2% cash.

**II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS**

The operations appropriation, funded with general revenues for \$719,630 the first year and \$729,189 the second year, has a \$2,700 increase for purchase of dictation/transcription equipment.
