<u>SB135</u>	RAPERT (Clemmer)	TO REDUCE THE STATE SALES AND USE TAX ON FOOD AND FOOD INGREDIENTS IF CERTAIN FUND BALANCES EXIST; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.
<u>SB298</u>	J. DISMANG (Dotson)	TO CREATE AN EXEMPTION FROM THE SALES AND USE TAX FOR UTILITIES USED BY A GRAIN DRYING AND STORAGE FACILITY.
<u>SB299</u>	TEAGUE (Bragg)	TO AMEND THE SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION FOR TIMBER HARVESTING MACHINERY, EQUIPMENT, AND RELATED ATTACHMENTS.
<u>SB463</u>	J. HENDREN (Julian)	TO CREATE AN EXEMPTION FROM THE INCOME TAX FOR SERVICE PAY OR ALLOWANCES RECEIVED BY ACTIVE DUTY MEMBERS OF THE ARMED SERVICES.
<u>SB791</u>	B. SAMPLE (Deffenbaugh)	TO REDUCE THE SALES AND USE TAX ON NATURAL GAS AND ELECTRICITY USED BY MANUFACTURERS.
<u>SB853</u>	TEAGUE (Ferguson)	TO CREATE AN EXEMPTION FROM THE SALES AND USE TAX FOR DENTAL APPLIANCES SOLD BY OR TO DENTISTS OR CERTAIN OTHER PROFESSIONALS.
<u>SB1091</u>	FILES (Edwards)	TO AMEND THE DISPOSITION OF REVENUES GENERATED BY THE AD VALOREM TAX ASSESSED ON CERTAIN UTILITIES AND CARRIERS.
<u>SB334</u>	FILES (Wren)	TO REDUCE THE SALES AND USE TAX RELATING TO THE PARTIAL REPLACEMENT AND REPAIR OF MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN MANUFACTURING; AND TO PROVIDE A REFUND MECHANISM FOR CERTAIN SALES AND USE TAXES.
<u>SB256</u>	IRVIN (House)	TO ALLOW AN ARKANSAS MARRIAGE LICENSE TO BE USED IN OTHER JURISDICTIONS.
