PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1003** of the Regular Session of the Eighty-ninth General Assembly provides for a recess of the session until Friday, May 17, 2013, and authorizes the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, by Joint Proclamation, to reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 Noon, May 17, 2013, for considering vetoes, correcting errors and oversights, or omissions, completing its work on proposed constitutional amendments, considering any issues that may arise concerning Amendment 82 authorized project, considering any issue concerning state funded or federally funded programs, and considering the need for further extension of the Regular Session of the Eighty-ninth General Assembly, or to adjourn the Regular Session of the Eighty-ninth General Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 17, 2013, if they determine it not necessary to reconvene.

NOW THEREFORE, We, the undersigned Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate of the Regular Session of the 89th General Assembly of Arkansas, pursuant to the provisions of **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1003** of the Regular Session of the Eighty-ninth General Assembly, hereby direct that the Regular Session of the Eighty-ninth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas shall reconvene at 10:00 a.m., Friday, May 17, 2013, for the following purpose:

- 1) To adjourn the Eighty-ninth General Assembly Regular Session Sine Die.
