The Board is a licensing and regulatory organization created to protect the public from incompetent, unprofessional and unlawful practice of physical therapy. Laws are established to set forth standards for the practice of physical therapy, continuing education and testing, and to define the scope and limitations of practice. The board receives, investigates and adjudicates complaints against licensees.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2013 is \$257,213.

The State Board of Physical Therapy is a cash funded agency funded from licensure and renewal fees.

PROFESSIONAL FEES: Special language prohibits board members from performing any investigative work that may be required by the board.
