Each petition shall be substantially in the following form:

"The undersigned, duly qualified electors of the City of, Arkansas, each signer hereof residing at the address set opposite his signature, hereby requests that the name of be placed on the ballot as a candidate for election to Position No. on the Board of Directors (or Mayor) of said City of at the election to be held in such city on the day of, 1920 We further state that we know said person to be a qualified elector of said city and a person of good moral character and qualified in our judgment for the duties of such office;"
