 (AN ACT TO AMEND THE TRAUMA SYSTEM ACT)

Dear Representative Petrus and Senator Critcher:

HB 1575, which would amend the Trauma System Act by creating the Trauma System Revolving Trust Fund and funding the statewide trauma system, was referred to a conference committee on March 27.

The conference committee met on March 30 and April 2 to discuss this legislation, but failed to reach a consensus. On April 2, a motion was made by Senator Tracy Steele to increase the insurance premium tax collected from insurance companies by twenty-five hundredths percent (.25%) on all kinds of insurance other than premiums for individual life insurance policies; to increase the DWI fine by \$50; and for all proceeds to be paid to the Trauma System Revolving Trust Fund to fund a state trauma system. This motion passed by voice vote by the Senate conference members. Representative Denny Sumpter made an identical motion for the House conference members which failed by voice vote.
