Remarks by Speaker Robert S. Moore, Jr.

Monday 2-13-2012

I think each of you realize that we are here for a very specific and limited purpose. Some of you have not had the pleasure of going through a fiscal session before. It gets intense but under the constraints of the 86th amendment to the constitution our mandate is extremely clear. That is to, if you look at the precise wording of the mandate, consider appropriation bills only. Now, there is a provision in there for a super majority of us that think there are other matters that need to be considered to come together to coincidence non-fiscal matters. There are a couple of issues out there that are pending and we will give due consideration to that but clearly, the frames of that amendment wanted us to come up here to take care of lousiness that deals with the budget, make good decision, and go back home to our constituents. Now, there is a lot of speculation, if you go back to 2008 when the amendment was passed, a lot of us in this room and a lot around the state were pretty surprised when it passed, and I was one of them as well as some of you, but there is speculation as to why it passed. I consider it to be due to 2 budget categories of voters. One of them is the informed voter that probably has a good business background and have to but their eyes on the budget a little more often to see your revenues coming in and what your expenses are, monitoring it a little closer to likely do a better job. You can rest assured that these people who voted for it wanted us to come down here to do just that; make our concerns, come together, see our revenues, and pass that budget in a swift manner.

The other group of folks that voted for it for some unknown reason, and woke up the next day, and saw what they had done. You can rest assured that those folks want us to get up here as quickly as we can and get out of town. However you look at the overwhelming majority that voted for the amendment, I think it is clear that the voters of Arkansas want us to come up and focus on the business at hand, take care of it, and then go back home.

This does give us the opportunity to look at our budget on a more frequent basis. We do have items to be considered that are obviously important and are deserving of our attention beyond regular basis. As you all know, a big ticket item that we will be looking at will be funding for Medicaid. This is Medicaid that provides medical services for those who are most needy: the elderly, the young, and the poorest amongst us. We know that medical costs have been rising at an alarming rate, and until we are able to find the right solution, which continues to be in the works, to get

control of those rising costs, we certainly owe it to the 700,000+ Arkansans that are depending on us to see that they get the medical care that they need and deserve. We also could not have foreseen a year ago the unfortunate circumstances that have developed within the forestry commission. As you all know to justify reallocating funds within the department to bring 15 of our firefighters back to work. I know that everybody in here joins me in being appreciative of being able to bring those firefighters back to do the job of protecting our forests and the people of the state of Arkansas. Now, it would be somewhat of an anomaly if we found the money to bring 15 firefighters back and we ended up having to lay off a bunch of other folks in that department, which is what will happen if we don't pass an appropriation to meet the deficiency of funding just to get the department through the end of the year. Of course we always have education at the top of our agenda with additional funding to meet the needs of adequacy to continue our progress.

I think that when the framers of amendment 86 put it together, they didn't intend for us to come together to reinvent the budget wheel but rather to come down here and keep the train on the track and keep it moving along. Those us who are in our last term have come together over 4 budget sessions now conservatively as legislators working with the Governor to produce a budget for the state of Arkansas that will put us in a inviolable position amongst the other great states of our nation. We right now are only 1 of 8 states that are operating in the black. So that tells you we have been under, we have come together, across the aisles of the legislative body and working with the Governor to do what is expected, provide services to our citizens, and not to have to do the mass layoffs that we have seen in many of the states around the country.

We have a million of good ideas out there. I have no doubt about it that all of them come to the surface because we recognize that we don't have to come to agreement on all the same programs that we should be involved with or on the amount of money that should be spent on the programs that we do involve ourselves with. That is what we are going to be doing over the next few weeks. Sharing those ideas, but I ask that you work for the people that you represent as you bring forth those ideas, that you work in a state of always being committed to come together to find a common ground of agreement. If we do that, we can do our work and complete it in an efficient, effective, and extraditions manner. If we are making our contributions knowing that we must avoid a characterization like that of the folks in Washington D. C. that we don't want to be like, because we don't want to go into gridlock and we

don't want to deal with distractions that takes us away from the business of the people. Come together, common ground, efficient, effective, extraditions.

If you need motivation and inspiration to do this, in Arkansas, that is pretty easy to come by. Look around you, look back home to your teachers in the classroom who didn't give up on their kids, we didn't give up on funding the educational needs of our children, closing things at the state and local level so that we aren't in the position that we used to be in that we aren't in anymore. In the last few weeks, we were recognized in the education week magazine for Arkansas being number 5 in the nation for policy and performance of education in our schools. We can rightly applaud ourselves but also the teachers because they are the ones doing the work and making it happen. If we continue to do our job, they will continue to do theirs and we will continue to be where we want to be, not thank God for Mississippi but number 1 where everyone chasing us. Also if you need inspiration, think back about everyone that came together during the disasters that have faced the state: the tornados, the ice storms, and the flooding that impacted so many parts of our state last spring and summer. The first responders at the local, county, and state level, but not just those people, the people who came together in your communities, counties, and districts to work together, to take care of those who were displaced, or standing in lines with sand bags to keep the flood waters out. Think about that in the state of Arkansas, we have over 300,000 people that one involved in volunteer efforts. These are people that are in your schools, they are your senior citizens that are volunteering in your local government organizations or state organizations. These are people like you that are doing what they want to do because they believe in it and they come together to accomplish a common goal for the sake of Arkansans. That ought to be our inspiration during the next few weeks: coming together for the benefit of all Arkansans. I want to let you again how proud I am that you prove that Democrats and Republicans can come together and we can do the work of the people

When I addressed you back at the beginning of the 88th General Assembly, I asked everyone to focus on the key items that were important to everyone in the state and everyone in your district. You responded in a most exemplary way. We were able to come together in difficult times across the aisles, Democrat and Republicans. We passed a water plan that "Robert Bale" planted that seed. Back when we were beginning "Robert Bale" said "we ought to be coming down here, not worried about what they're talking about in the papers back home, but what we're doing for the generations that follow us 20 years down the road. " All of you took that lead and

took that challenge and we passed that plan. You're going to be getting some information about that, I've got an email I will be sending out. Things are working great on that. You came together in very adverse times. You recognized that we had a funding deficiency in our decaying infrastructure highway department and you passed a highway bill. That has already resulted in the people approving the renewal of the Garvee bonds. They're going to provide substantial highway funding. There was a part of that particular bill that didn't come about as we intended because of a little nickel diesel tax, a little dangling end, and I'm going to ask you later on to be taking care of that. We also have another measure that will come to the people in November that will allow us to have the opportunity to fund an infrastructure system in the state of Arkansas that would be envious to the entire nation. You also came together and passed ethics reform. It wasn't everything that we all wanted, but it was a step in the right direction. It was something that no general assembly had done in many many years in this particular chamber, but you had the fortitude to come together democrats and republicans to get that done. We passed a criminal justice reform act that's going to make our streets safer as it's implemented. The cost of our incarceration a more palatable within the means of our tax payers and do a better job at identifying those that we need to invest in to rehabilitate to bring them back into society. So you've already proved that we can do this. Maybe most important, we all came together and did something called tax relief. We passed some tax relief for citizens of the great state of Arkansas. All of these measures, it wasn't democrat, it wasn't republican, it was all of us coming together to get it done. So we've proved that we can do it, and I ask now as we go forward and see ourselves continue down that road of good stewards for the people of the state of Arkansas, that we strive for the good works that we do, we strive not to be remembered in name, or recognized in name, but to be remembered and recognized for the benefits that our works produce for the benefit of the people of our great state.

I want to close by telling you one thing that I brought to you, back when I made my remarks at the beginning of the 88th Regular Session from my good friend Billy Joe Shaver. Something for us to think about as we move forward in this harmonious body that we're going to be in. Billy Joe said "always remember it's nice to be important, but it's more important to be nice." So, let's come together for the common purpose of representing the people of our great state and do some good things, and do it in the quick fashion they intended for us to do. Thank you very much.

Governor's Address

Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, and welcome back Mr. Massanelli.

It's a nostalgic occasion for those in this room who are attending their last session because of term limits, saving except of course a special session which all of us hope is unnecessary.

So for all of you, I hope you will drink up and enjoy the actual feeling that you have every time you sit at this desk and pass on major public policy issues for your constituents specifically, and the constituents of our state at large.

I recall the feelings I had in my last session as a state senator and the nostalgia will creep back in as the session progresses. It is an honored group that you all are comprised of, and you don't get enough credit for all of the hard work that you do. We have our differences from time to time. You have your differences among each other from time to time, but in the final analysis, you're the first branch of government, and you're the first branch of government for a reason.

The founding fathers decided that the legislative branch would be the folks that are in charge of public policy and in charge of the money. And since you're in charge of the public policy and in charge of the money, the other two branches of government usually fall in line. It is my job to propose. It is your job to dispose. That doesn't mean that you're free from proposing yourself because you have that obligation as well and I receive your proposals and sometimes adopt them as my own, sometimes applaud your initiative, and sometimes wonder where you came up with the idea to begin with.

You all dispose, but if I can help dispose, that's part of my job as well. So I don't shirk from the responsibility of being of help and assistance to you as I can. I am also cognizant and mindful of the internal workings of these two houses and have always been mindful of how I felt as a senator when I thought a governor overstepped his bounds in dealing with the internal policies, and I try to refrain from doing that.

This is our second historic fiscal session. The first session was short, sweet and to the point. It was a fiscal session and you had another matter that you dealt with, but you dealt with in a form of consensus that caused it not to prolong or unduly harass the intent of the voters with regard to the purpose of a fiscal session.

I urge and applaud you to take that same approach this time. Many of you will be filing for reelection or filing for other offices within the timeframe of the session, and I know I can speak for you when I say you all want to be out of here as fast as I want you to be out of here. Obviously, after first having done the people's business.

We have together weathered this economic recession in a fashion and a manner that most other states would be envious of. We are not immune. We've had our share of problems. We are not immune. We've had our people laid off. We are not immune. We've seen certain revenue sources decline, some of which we are asked to address in this session.

Nevertheless, compared to virtually every other state in the country, Arkansas has weathered this economic downturn – the worst in my lifetime – better than virtually any other state, and a large part of that is the conservative, rational, reasonable budgetary approaches that you have all taken, and you deserve credit for it.

I will tell you that we are continuing that theme with my proposed budget. It is a relatively flat budget. Two major areas of increase are first of all K-12, with adequacy increases as defined by you. The Constitution, the statutory laws, and the Lakeview case all recognize that the Legislature will determine adequacy and once it is determined by the Legislature, it's incumbent on the rest of us to fall in line and fund that adequacy. My proposed budget does precisely that. It addresses that first priority of K-12 and adequacy, both in the letter and the spirit of the law.

The other major increase in the proposed budget is for Medicaid. It is a substantial increase as increases go for this session, but merely a small portion of what we're going to face in the long run going down the road. That's why we continue to try to work together for issues that won't be addressed necessarily in this session but of a substantive nature going forward to try to get a handle on the ever-escalating healthcare costs that strike all of us in the private sector as well as the public sector but specifically strikes all of us in state government because of our Medicaid responsibilities.

Other than that and a few minor tweaks, the rest of the budget is relatively flat. I think all of us would like to see increases for our state employees, and I'd be the first to say I wished we'd had it. We've hunted, and searched, and looked to try to find it. Hopefully there will be some savings in various budgets with some degree of merit, or some degree of individual assistance can be provided by the agencies, but across-the-board from the legislative session is something that there's just not the money to provide.

We will also ask for some supplemental funding. Most of you have seen that. It's been your leadership that requested that this information and my requests in that regard be disseminated early so that you had the opportunity to look at it, and digest it, and make up your minds as to the validity of any of those requests. That's all been done, and hopefully you've had the opportunity to look at that.

We had about \$70 million in surplus money, which incidentally, that's been lauded nationally, since most states haven't had any surplus money. Of that 70, roughly 30 million is being requested in supplementals. For those who did not know or may have forgotten, what is not spent in supplementals goes into your General Improvement Fund pot next time as a basis, or a base, for general improvement monies, which are always needed for the capital needs of our state. But in the interim, in the meantime, those necessary items to be funded with supplementals are usually the first call off of those monies, and the request is in there for all of you to be able to see with regard to what those requests are.

There may be some other items that members have suggested. I have tried to be open and responsive to understanding those requests. The only thing I would ask is that you keep them as limited as possible and that you work together in a fashion that it doesn't delay this session and that it doesn't break faith with the people who actually voted to have annual sessions in the even numbered years, which would be devoted strictly to fiscal matters. I think the people understand that if there's a tweak or two here in a very limited fashion that requires to be done that they can live with that if it doesn't prolong or otherwise endangered the main purpose of this session.

Lastly, let me say that there's this old adage that all of us, I think, have been privy to from time to time about, "Everybody hates Congress, but everybody loves their congressman. Everybody hates the Legislature, but everybody loves their legislator." Well, in today's world, those things are changing a little bit. You all have seen the polls and heard the anecdotal evidence. Congress' public popularity is at

an all-time low. And what we're hearing more often than not now is they don't like anybody up there. The University of Arkansas poll, which came out last fall as I recall, shocked a lot of people because it bragged on the public opinion ratings of the Arkansas Legislature. I was frankly pleasantly surprised because for years I'd heard that adage about nobody liked us when I was in the Legislature, but everybody liked their legislator.

So when I saw the approval ratings for the Arkansas Legislature that was significantly higher than what most people thought it would have been, it made me proud of you. You can fuss, and you can fight, and you can argue, and that's what the process is all about. But when you do it in a civil manner; when you do it with an eye or a view toward ultimately being able to come together to resolve the problems of our people; when you distinguish yourself from those other places around the country, where those other places and Washington who just fight for the sake of fighting, then that goes down in the eyes of our people as a very positive sign. It does not go unnoticed.

You all can continue that tradition in this fiscal session. I hope that you will strive to continue to be able to do what I heard the Speaker ask the House to do in his speech a little bit earlier, and that is to, when you disagree, do it agreeably; when you want to solve a problem, you try to build a consensus; and when you go home, you realize that you all are charged with the responsibility of making Arkansas a better place to live, to work, to raise a family and to educate ourselves.

I have great respect for the legislative process. I spent 20 years sitting where you sit. It is not the prettiest form of government, its certainly not the most efficient form of government, but in the history of the world, there has never been a better system of government for self-rule, for representative government, for democracy and for the people than this form of government. By your actions and by your attendance and by your hard work, you continue that tradition – a tradition the American people started over two centuries ago and which you continue today. I'm there to help when I can; I'm there to listen when I need to. That doesn't mean we'll always agree, but what it does mean is that we are in this together.

We have two bosses. I said in my first inaugural that we represent a proud people and a mighty God. Let's make them proud.
