The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy protects the health and well-being of the public through regulating the practice of massage therapy. The board is responsible for licensing, promoting education, and administering exams. The Board has statutory authority to examine and inspect all massage therapy schools, offices, and clinics in Arkansas. The Board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor.

The total budget for the Massage Therapy Board is \$151,602 the first year and \$153,683 the second year of the biennium.
