TO PROVIDE FOR A RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON MARCH 19, 2014; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON, MARCH 26, 2014; TO AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MARCH 26, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES, CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, OR TO ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MARCH 26, 2014, THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE; AND TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL RECESSES OF EITHER OR BOTH CHAMBERS FOR PERIODS OF FOUR (4) CONSECUTIVE DAYS OR LONGER.
