SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-704(c)(1), concerning the requirement that an applicant for an original driver's license possess a valid instruction permit properly issued not less than thirty (30) days before the date of application, is amended to read as follows:

(c)(1) ~~No~~ An applicant for an original license, ~~that is, an applicant who is~~ under sixteen (16) years of age and who has never been licensed previously by any jurisdiction, shall not be permitted to demonstrate ability to operate a motor vehicle as required under the provisions of this chapter unless ~~and until~~ the applicant has in his or her possession a valid instruction permit properly issued not less than thirty (30) days ~~prior to~~ before the date of application, unless otherwise determined by the office.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-16-802(a)(1) and (2), concerning the issuance of instruction permits, are amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) Any person who is at least fourteen (14) years of age may apply to the ~~Office of Driver Services~~ Department of Arkansas State Police for an instruction permit.

(2) After the applicant has successfully passed all parts of the examination other than the driving test, the ~~office~~ department ~~may~~, in its discretion, may issue to the applicant an instruction permit ~~which that~~ shall entitle the applicant while having the permit in his or her immediate possession to drive a motor vehicle upon the public highways for a period of six (6) months when accompanied by a licensed driver who is at least twenty-one (21) years of age and who is occupying a seat beside the driver, except in the event that the permittee is operating a motorcycle.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-16-802(b)(1), concerning the issuance of instruction permits, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) The ~~office~~ department, upon receiving proper application ~~may~~, in its discretion, may issue a restricted instruction permit effective for a school year or a more restricted permit to an applicant who is enrolled in a driver education program ~~which that~~ includes practice driving and ~~which that~~ is approved by the office even though the applicant has not reached the legal age to be eligible for a noncommercial license."
