(b) If a retiree declines to participate in the program upon returning to active employment under subdivision (a)(5)(B)(ii)(a) of this section, the retiree may participate in the program based on the year of the retiree's most recent enrollment in the program.

(iii) A retiree who declines to participate in the program at the time of retirement is not considered continuously enrolled in the program."
