State agency involved: ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (ADC) Amount sought: Correct the Amount of Lien Plus \$250.00 to my account
Month, day, year and place of incident or service: Ongoing since 1-14-2011 but I just learned of in 2014
Explanation: The ADC is attempting to extort funds from me by/through Liens against my inmate account for Legal Postage and Legal copy fees which grossly exaggerate the actual amount. I am disputing the amount of the Lien against my account because I know I have NOT SENT out that much legal work and the ADC cannot produce inmate withdrawal forms with my signature on them to equal the challenged amount of \$ 407.94 (EX "A"). I have been indigent since 2011, I appealed out in 2013 and have been back since July of 2014. Whenever I learned that the ADC were grossly overcharging me with the current liens, I filed an informal resolution on 11-10-14 challenging the amount and requesting that it be corrected and in response, the Business Manager, Ms. Smallwood ~~advised me~~ failed to respond. See EXHIBIT No. #1. On 11-17-14, I went to step two which on 1-16-15 warden Watson found to be without merit because Ms. Smallwood advised him I had liens on my account since 1-14-2011 for legal postage see EXHIBIT #2. But, I was challenging the amount of the liens. So on 1-20-15 I appealed to Director's office and placed it in Truck-Mail to avoid more postage liens but, my appeal was not stamped as received until Feb. 18, 2015. See Exhibit No. #2 and Chief Deputy Director Dale Reed rejected my appeal as untimely see Exhibit No. #3. The appeal was dated 1-20-15 just four (4) days after the warden's response - I had five (5) working days. I placed it in Truck-Mail Box on 1-20-15. After that, I had no control over it.

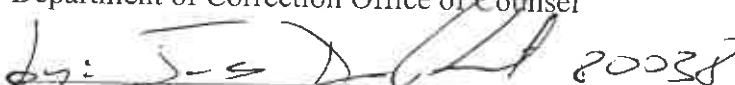
ANSWER

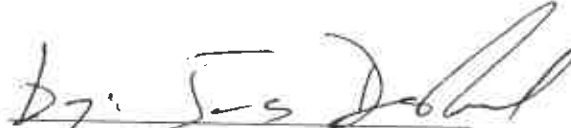

REQUEST FOR ADMISSION NO. #2: Please admit that indigent Prisoners are Required to Complete and Sign an inmate Personal withdrawal request form, have it Signed by a Sergeant or above witness, then attach it to outgoing legal Correspondence before the mail room will Place Postage on the envelope.

REQUEST FOR ADMISSION NO. #3: Please Admit that indigent Prisoners are Provided with Writ Paper ("Typing Paper") and UN-stamped envelopes to draft and mail Legal documents in [at state expense] with no Liens being Placed against their accounts in compliance with what the United States Supreme Court held in Bonds v. Smith, 430 U.S. 817, at 824-25, NO. # 3, 4, 5, and 6 (1977).

Smith SUPRA Id. at 824-25, NO. # 3, 4, 5 and 6 held that "It is indisputable that indigent inmates must be Provided at state expense with Paper and Pen to draft legal documents ... and with Stamps (Postage) to mail them", and that ADC Policy A.D. #11-46 - inmates liens which Place liens against

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Indigent Prisoners' account for Postage to mail legal documents is in direct Conflict with what Bonds v. Smith, Supra held.

REQUEST FOR ADMISSION NO. #5: Please admit that the State of ARKANSAS Allocates Funds within an annual fiscal Budget to the ADC that are designed Specifically to mail legal documents of indigent Prisoners in Compliance with the Ruling in Bonds v. Smith Supra.

REQUEST FOR ADMISSION NO. #6: Please admit that the ADC Violated two(2) Separate Court orders when it Continued to Create lien debts against Claimant's account when both Court orders Specifically Prohibited the State (or any of its offices) from Charging him for Postage and Copy Fees related to those cases. (Faulkner County Circuit Court Division 2, Case no. 23CV-11-901 and Division 3, Case no. 23CV-12-811 which were active during his incarceration from 9/16/11 until after his Parole on 9/3/13)

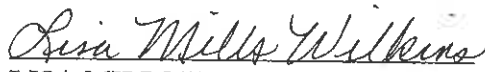

1. That the ADC has and continues to Place legal Postage liens against my Account in clear violation of well established U.S. Supreme Court Law which holds that "It is indisputable that indigent inmates must be provided at state expense with Paper and Pen to draft legal documents with Notarial services to authenticate them, and with stamps to mail them..." BONDS V. SMITH, 430 U.S. 817, at 825 (1977)

2. That between 9/16/11 and 9/3/13 when I was Paroled the ADC violated two (2) valid Court orders from Faulkner County Circuit Court, 2nd and 3rd Divisions by charging my inmate account with liens for Postage and Legal Copies incident to those cases when those Court orders specifically forbid such fees and cost. (See attached copies of said Court orders)

3. That the ADC's responses to my Request for admissions, Production of documents and Interrogatories do not comply with the Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure in that they do not Repeat each Request prior to the Response.

4. That the ADC's Refusal to Produce any of the documents requested interferes with my ability to further demonstrate Proof that the ADC is seeking to extort Funds from my account with these illegal liens. 7. That the ADC should be required to remove the Legal Postage and Copy Liens from my account, and discontinue the illegal Practice of Placing these liens on inmate accounts.

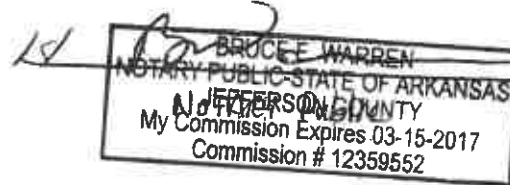

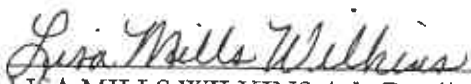
RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

COMES NOW the Respondent, Arkansas Department of Correction, and for its MOTION TO DISMISS, states and responds as follows:

1. Claimant alleges a failure to follow policy and seeks a refund of \$250. Claimant has failed to state a claim upon which relief can be granted under ARCP 12(b)(6) and this matter should be dismissed.
2. AD 11-46 provides for the collection of liens from 'future receipts to satisfy open liens', AD 11-46 II(A). The lien remains open until it is satisfied and AD 11-46 does not provide for the termination of the lien. Once he became an inmate again, the State has an obligation to enforce the lien. Exhibit "A".
3. Claimant admits to being indigent since 2011. His charges for postage and legal copies since that date are attached. See Exhibit "B". It would be difficult for him to recall all the mail he has sent over the previous 4 years. Such is understandable.
4. All transactions were properly made to Claimant's account. Unfortunately, Claimant must simply pay his own debts despite his attempt to circumvent this responsibility.
5. A motion to dismiss is proper when there are no facts upon which relief can be granted. ARCP 12(B)(6). Claimant can show no facts upon which he is entitled to relief and this claim should be dismissed.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated about and the evidence submitted, the Claims filed must be dismissed.

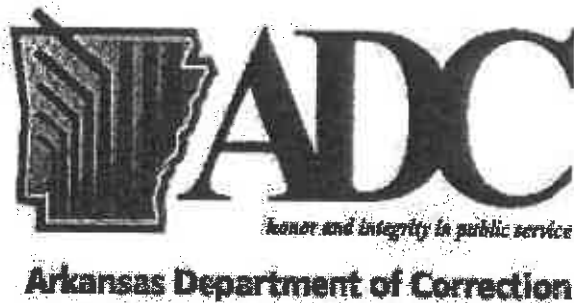

EFFECTIVE DATE: 6/10/2011

I. POLICY:

It shall be the policy of the Arkansas Department of Correction to provide a Lien Process for collection of monies owed by an inmate for purposes and as defined in the following procedures.

II. PROCEDURE:

A. Liens will be charged to an inmate's account for the below listed charges, and the collection of funds from future receipts to satisfy open liens will be applied in the below listed order.

1. Court Ordered Child Support – Collection of child support shall be as directed by the court.
2. Work Release Upkeep Rent – Collection of lien shall not reduce the account balance below \$25.00.
3. ADC Restitution – Collection of lien shall not reduce the account balance below \$5.00.

4. ID Card Replacement – Account balance of any amount shall be collected to satisfy lien.
 5. State Filing Fees – Collection of lien shall not reduce the account balance below \$10.00.
 6. Work Release Uniforms – Collection of lien shall not reduce the account balance below \$25.00.
 7. Federal Filing Fees Initial Partial – Collection of lien shall be collected as directed by the court.
 8. Federal Filing Fees Remaining Balance – Collection of lien will not reduce the account balance below \$10.00.
 9. Medical Co-Pay – Collection of lien will not reduce the account balance below \$5.00.
 10. Cost of Privileged Correspondence – Collection of lien will not reduce the account balance below \$5.00.
 11. Cost of Copier Usage for Legal Purposes – Collection of lien will not reduce the account balance below \$5.00.
 12. Cost of Postage & Proof of Delivery for Property Returns – Collection of lien will not reduce the account balance below \$5.00.
- B. “Holiday Funds” credited to eligible inmates during the month of December, as approved by the Board of Corrections, shall not be collected to satisfy any outstanding lien.
- C. “Holiday Prize Money” credited to an inmate’s account from the Inmate Welfare Fund shall not be collected to satisfy any outstanding lien.
- D. “Holiday Prize Money” credited to an inmate’s account from Inmate Council Funds shall be collected to satisfy any outstanding lien, subject to the above limitations.

CLAIMANT'S RESPONSE TO MOTION TO DISMISS

The Claimant, James Stickley, #086725, Pro-Se, Submits the Following for his RESPONSE TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS:

1. It is Quite Clear From Respondent's Motion to Dismiss that the Respondent as well as Respondent's Attorney have absolutely no respect for the rule of Law, that Respondent now seeks to undermine with its illegal Policy of Placing Liens against indigent Prisoners' accounts for Postage to mail Legal documents and for Legal Copies of said documents.

2. The Respondent admits that Claimant has been indigent (without Funds, and a Pauper) since 2011.

3. Concerning indigent Prisoners the rule of Law as explained by The United States Supreme Court Concerning Postage to mail Legal documents is Crystal Clear. The Supreme Court had the Following to say:

"... It is indisputable that indigent inmates must be Provided at state expense with Paper and Pen to draft legal documents with Notarial Services to Authenticate them, and with Stamps to mail them..." [Emphasis Supplied by Claimant] Bonds V. Smith, 430 U.S. 817 @ 825, (1977).

4. The Respondent does Provide (at state expense) Paper and Pen to draft Legal documents with Notarial Service. Yet, when it comes to Postage to mail said Legal documents, The Respondent Charges the indigent Prisoner with a Lien against his/her account See Claimant's Exhibit #1 attached hereto -

5. The Respondent's Policy Concerning Such Liens for Legal Postage is Contrary and in direct Conflict with the United States Supreme Court holding in Bonds vs. Smith, Supra.

6. Furthermore, The Claimant has already Provided the State Claims Commission with two (2) separate Court Orders out of Faulkner County Circuit Court which specifically Forbid Charging Claimant with Costs of Postage and Fees for Legal Copies which the Respondent ignored and Continued increasing the amount of the Lien against Claimant's account in spite of said Lawful Court Orders.

7. Not only is the ADC Policy, Administrative Directive NO. #11-46 in Clear violation of well established Law Concerning indigent inmates and Legal Postage and Legal Copies it is also a violation of Valid Court orders and constitutes among other things an attempt to Extort Funds From Claimant and other indigent inmates

8. IF the Respondent is allowed to Continue these illegal Practices which are in direct Conflict with Established Law, then Claimant and other Prisoners Should also be Permitted to Break the Law with such impunity. Just Because Respondent is a State Agency does not Authorize it to Violate the Law and Get away with it.

9. Since it is Clearly evident that the Respondent is Violating Clearly Established Law here with its Policy and Practice of Charging

Claimant who is truly indignant For Legal Postage and Copy FEES this Claim should not be dismissed but rather the Claims Commission should hold Respondent accountable for its illegal actions against Claimant, And Order such Practices to Cease at once.

Conclusion

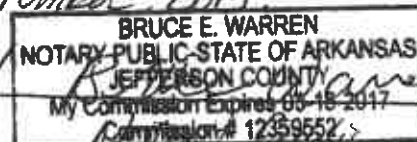

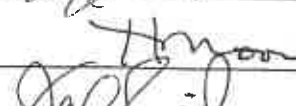
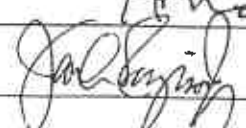

3. That the Faulkner County Circuit Court in two (2) separate Orders (case No. 23CV-11-901, 2ND Div., and case No. 23CV-12-811, 3RD Div.) Specifically Forbid the STATE or any office thereof From charging this Claimant for Cost of Postage and COPY fees.

Yet, the Department of Correction has and continues to ignore the Law on this subject by Placing a Lien against Claimants account for Legal Postage and COPY fees.

4. It is Clearly ILLEGAL for the Department of Correction to Charge indigent inmates such as Claimant for Legal Postage (and for legal copies of documents related to the two(2) Faulkner County Civil actions) And the STATE CLAIMS Commission denial and dismissal of Claimants Claim Should be SERIOUSLY Reconsidered (Because it Sanctions the ILLEGAL ACTIONS of the Department of Correction)

5. As the "CONSCIENCE OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS" the STATE CLAIMS Commission need only ask itself (individually), what if a state agency ILLEGALLY Placed a Lien against Your Bank account to obtain funds You simply did not owe, much less have?

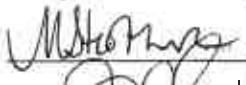
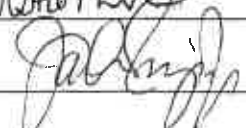

Comes now the Appellant, James Stickley, pro se with his Appeal from the Arkansas State Claims Commission ("ASCC") and sets forth the following Grounds for his appeal:

INDISPUTABLE FACTS:

1. Appellant is a Prisoner in the ADC.
2. Appellant is and has been indigent since Jan. 2011.
3. Appellee has and continues to charge Appellant for Postage fees to mail legal documents in direct conflict with U.S. Supreme Court Law and two(2) Faulkner County Circuit orders not to.
4. Appellee has charged Appellant costs of COPY for legal documents which two(2) Faulkner County Court orders prohibited.
5. That since Appellant was/is indigent the Appellee has placed liens against his Prison account for Postage fees and legal copies and for an amount that far exceeds the actual Postage and Copies made as well as in violation of the Law and Court Orders.

Ground no.#1:

The decision of the ASCC decision to dismiss and deny Stickley's Claim completely ignores U.S. Supreme Court Law and two(2) Valid Faulkner County Circuit Court orders that Prohibits the State from Charging Stickley (an indigent inmate) for Postage Fees and Legal Copies relating to Legal documents to the Courts.

The United States Supreme Court decisions have consistently required States to shoulder affirmative obligations to assure all prisoners meaningful access to the courts - Especially for Indigent inmates, which is explained in Bonds v. Smith, 490 U.S. 817 at 824-25, FN 3, 4, 5, and 6 (1977) where the High Court held:

"... It is indisputable that indigent inmates must be provided at STATE EXPENSE with Paper and Pen to draft legal documents with Notarial Services to authenticate them, and with stamps to mail them."

(Emphasis Supplied by Appellant)

Whenever Stickley has pointed to this in his Prose Pleadings before the ASCC, the Appellee has never once ever attempted to refute it, and the ASCC seems to have turned a blind eye to it, much like the proverbial ostrich who sticks its head in the sand to avoid the truth, and in so doing legitimizes the lawlessness of the ADC.

In addition to what the U.S. Supreme Court held in Bonds v. Smith, supra, Stickley has also submitted two(2) separate court orders out of Faulkner County Circuit Court which specifically forbid the State (or any office of the State) from charging Stickley for costs of legal copies and postage fees. These court orders were submitted to the ASCC on more than one occasion and Appellant submits both now for this Claims Review Committee to consider. See attached EXHIBIT No. #1 and EXHIBIT No. #2 which are copies of Case No. 23CV-11-901, 2ND Div. and Case No. 23CV-12-811, 3RD Div., court orders out of Faulkner County Circuit Court granting leave to proceed IN FORMA PAUPERIS, and at no. #4 on both it clearly states:

"4. That no other office of the state shall require of the Plaintiff any fees or cost incident to Plaintiff's action, including the cost for legal copies and postage fees incident to Plaintiff Stickley's civil action."

Once again the ARCC turned a blind eye, ignoring these valid Court orders and in so doing it says it's OK for ADC to violate the law and valid Court ~~orders~~, Legitimizing its Lawlessness.

At the very least the ADC should be ordered to Cease and desist its Policy of Placing Liens against indigent inmates' accounts for Postage fees.

And should be ordered to remove/Lift the Postage and legal COPY Liens from Stickley's Account—

GROUND NO. # 2:

The ASCC Clearly has a double standard in what it requires for Pleadings from ADC and Stickley.

Whenever Stickley Pointed out to the ASCC that the ADC had Failed to COMPLY with the Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure which requires Answering Request for Admissions and Interrogatories to repeat each Requested interrogatory and Request for admission immediately before answering (which the ADC did not do) the ASCC turned a blind eye to it stating that the answers were appropriate.

Yet, When Stickley Failed to send in the required amount of copies of his motion for reconsideration, Brenda Wade, The ASCC director was Quick to Point out to Stickley with a threat not to Provide him with a file marked COPY next time.

• CONCLUSION •

WHEREFORE, For the Foregoing Reasons Stickley would ask that the ADC be required to remove the Liens from his account and not add anymore for Legal Postage and Legal copies.

Forget his Request for \$250.⁰⁰, Just require the ADC to Recognize and abide by the Law.

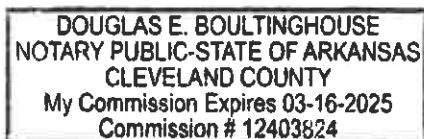
