7. Disability Determination for Social Security Administration - Disability Determination

In an effort to reduce the number of disability claims waiting for face-to-face hearings with federal administrative law judges, the Social Security Administration has granted us \$250,000 to offer adjudicators overtime to eliminate this backlog of hearing. Also, a change in positions is needed to provide slots for 30 employees who will be needed to handle an expected increase in disability claims for the Social Security Administration (SSA). To be prepared for this increase in workload, SSA has asked that we act now to hire and train employees. In addition, with the increased production, our "Professional Services" fund will need to be increased to accommodate increased payments for medical records.
