The EECBG program will cover four categories: Energy Efficiency Audits, Energy Efficiency Retrofits for Government Agencies and Non-Profits, Workforce Development, and Micro Mobility Initiative. AEO will launch a competitive grant mainly targeting small cities and counties that did not receive direct allocations for DOE.
