HB1163	D. Hutchinson	TO ENSURE THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HAS ADEQUATE INFORMATION TO MAKE INFORMED DECISIONS ON HIGHWAY FUNDING BEFORE EACH REGULAR SESSION AND EACH FISCAL SESSION.
HB1283	G. Smith	TO CLARIFY THAT A PERSON OR OTHER ENTITY WITHOUT A TOWING LICENSE MAY TOW A VEHICLE THAT IT OWNS; TO MAKE OTHER CHANGES FOR CLARITY AND CONSISTENCY.
HB1294	H. Wilkins	TO AMEND THE CHILD PASSENGER PROTECTION ACT AND THE MANDATORY SEAT BELT LAW TO REQUIRE SEAT BELT USE ON ALL SCHOOL BUSES IF THE BUS WAS PURCHASED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2013.
