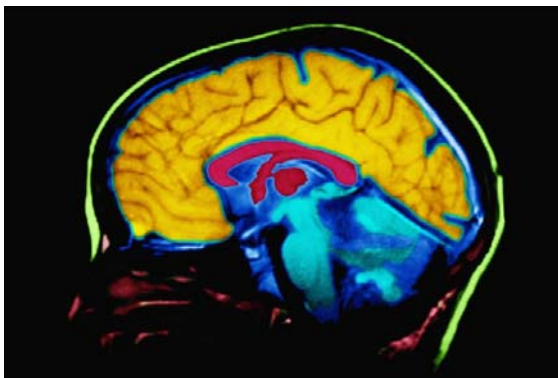
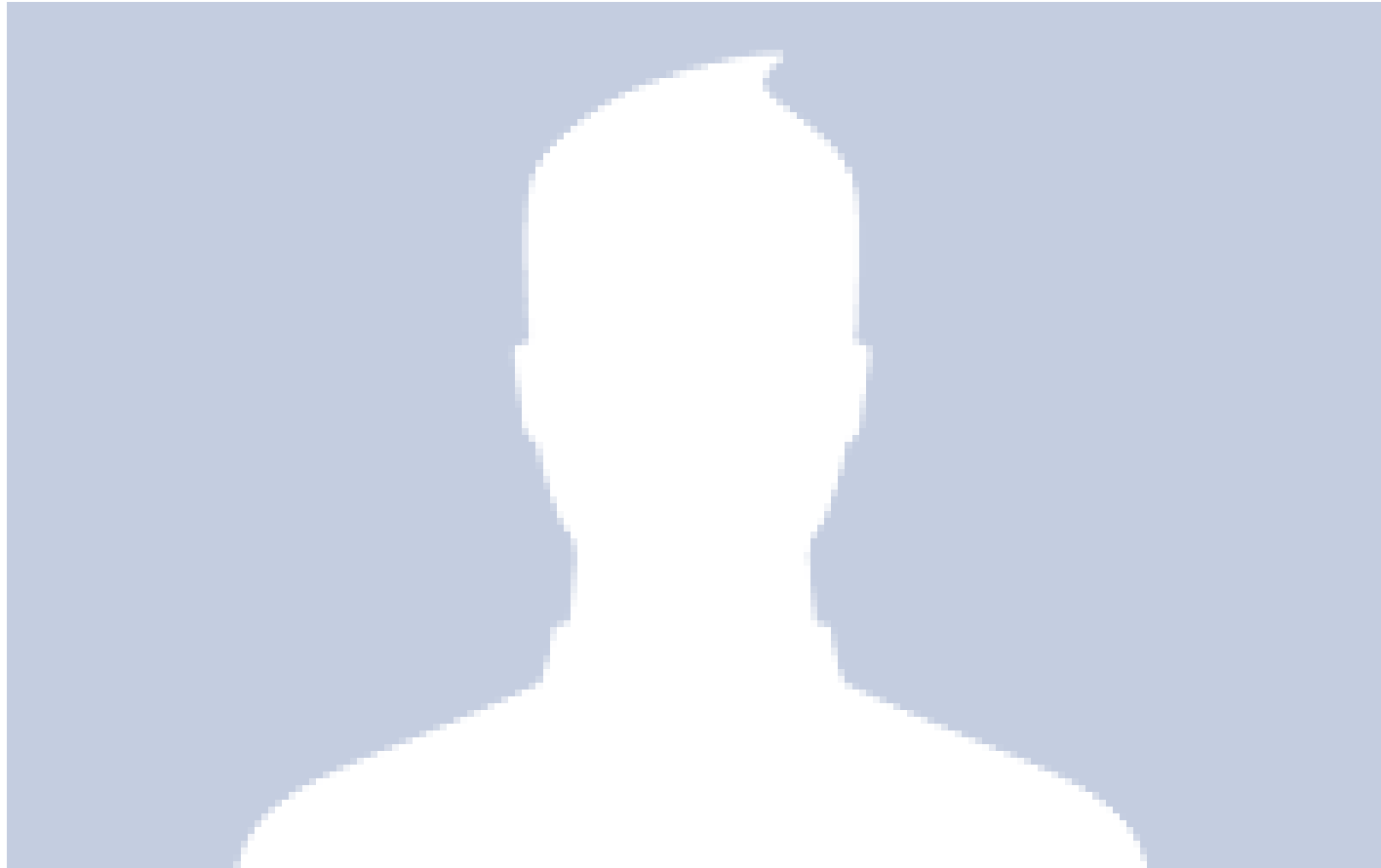

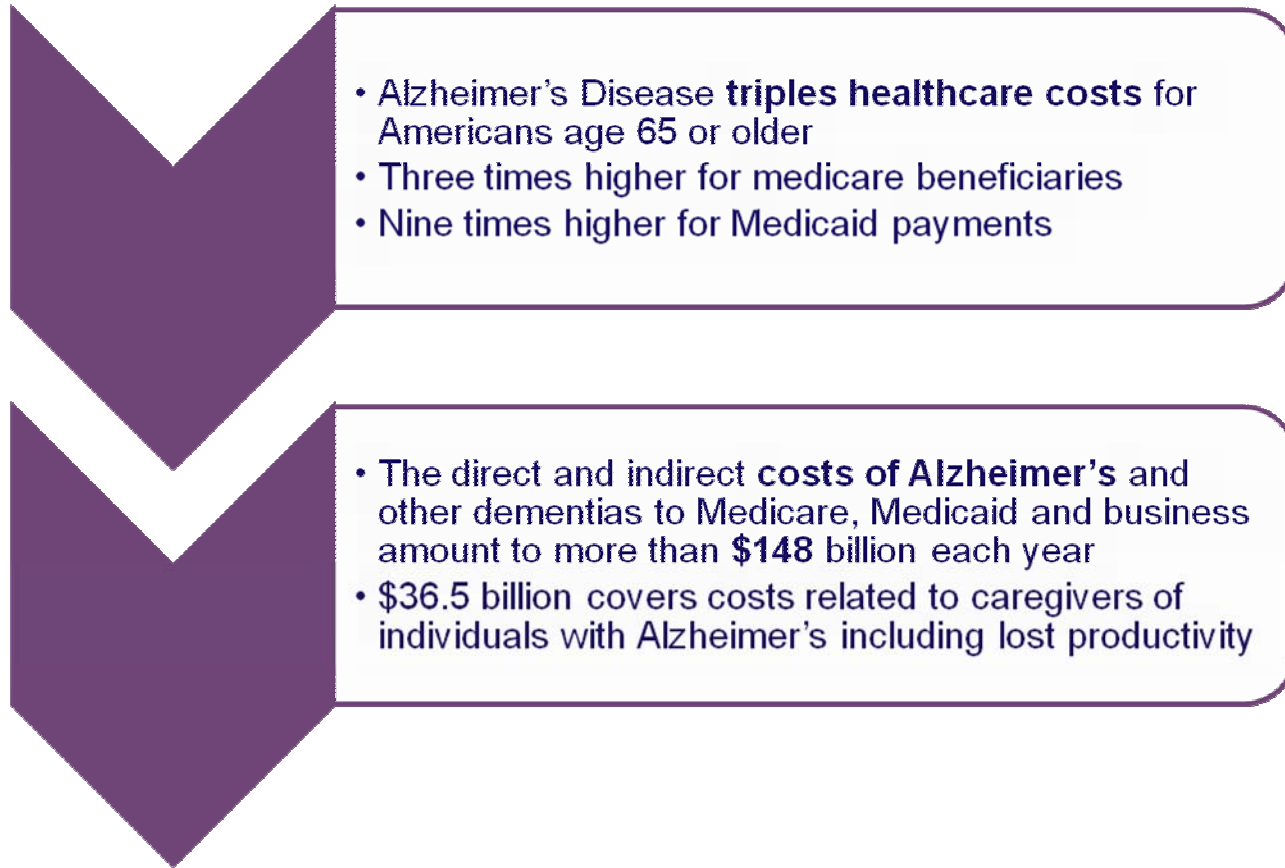
Alzheimer's Disease:

- 5.3 million Americans and 100,000 Arkansans*
- 47% of AR nursing home residents have some form of cognitive impairment
- Every 70 seconds, someone in the U.S. develops Alzheimer's. By 2050, it'll be every 33 seconds.

Impact on Families and Community

Almost 10 million Americans providing 8.5 billion hours of unpaid care to people with Alzheimer's disease or other dementia, valued at \$94 billion

57%

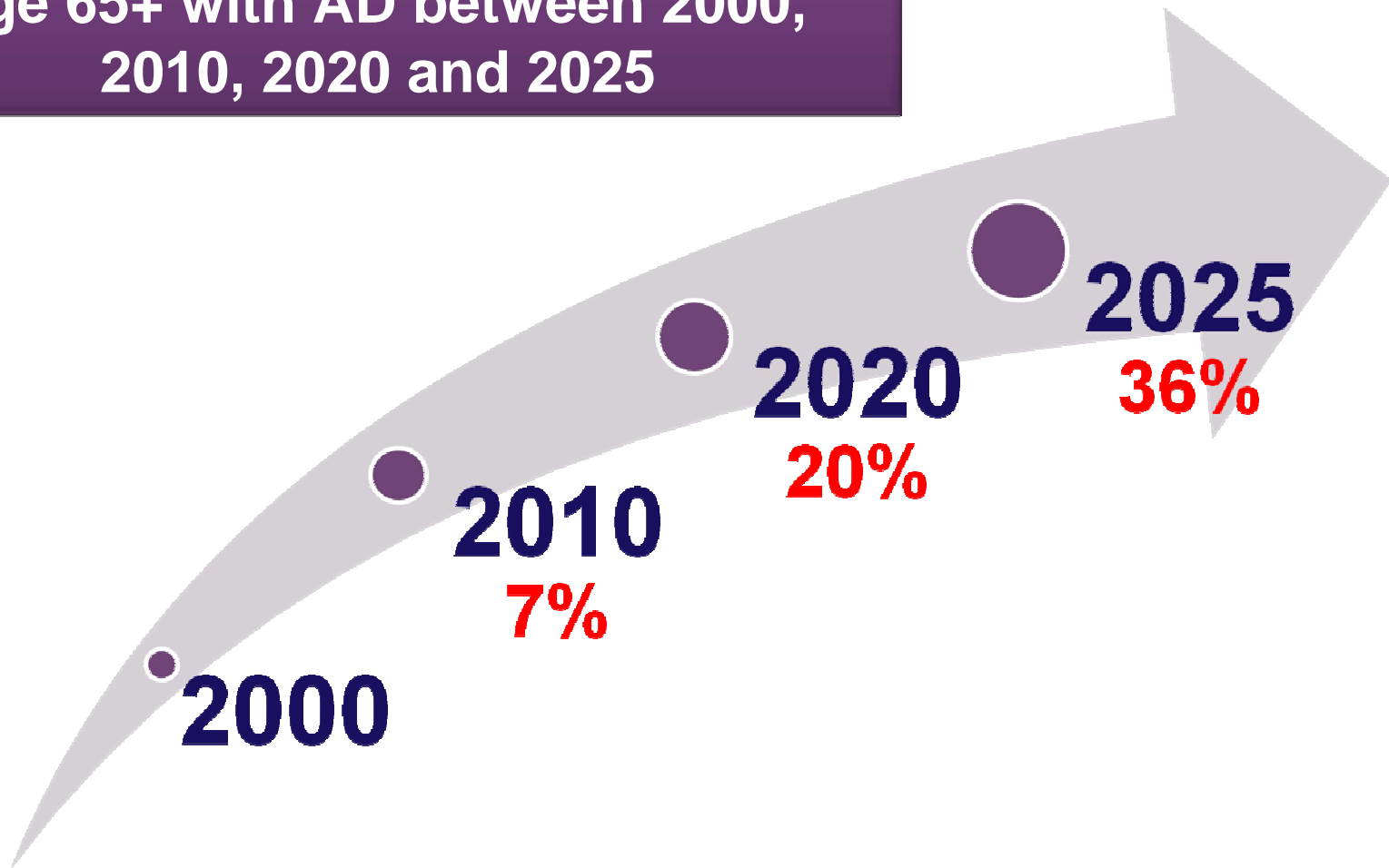
- Of family caregivers of people with Alzheimer's or other dementias are employed either full time or part time

49%

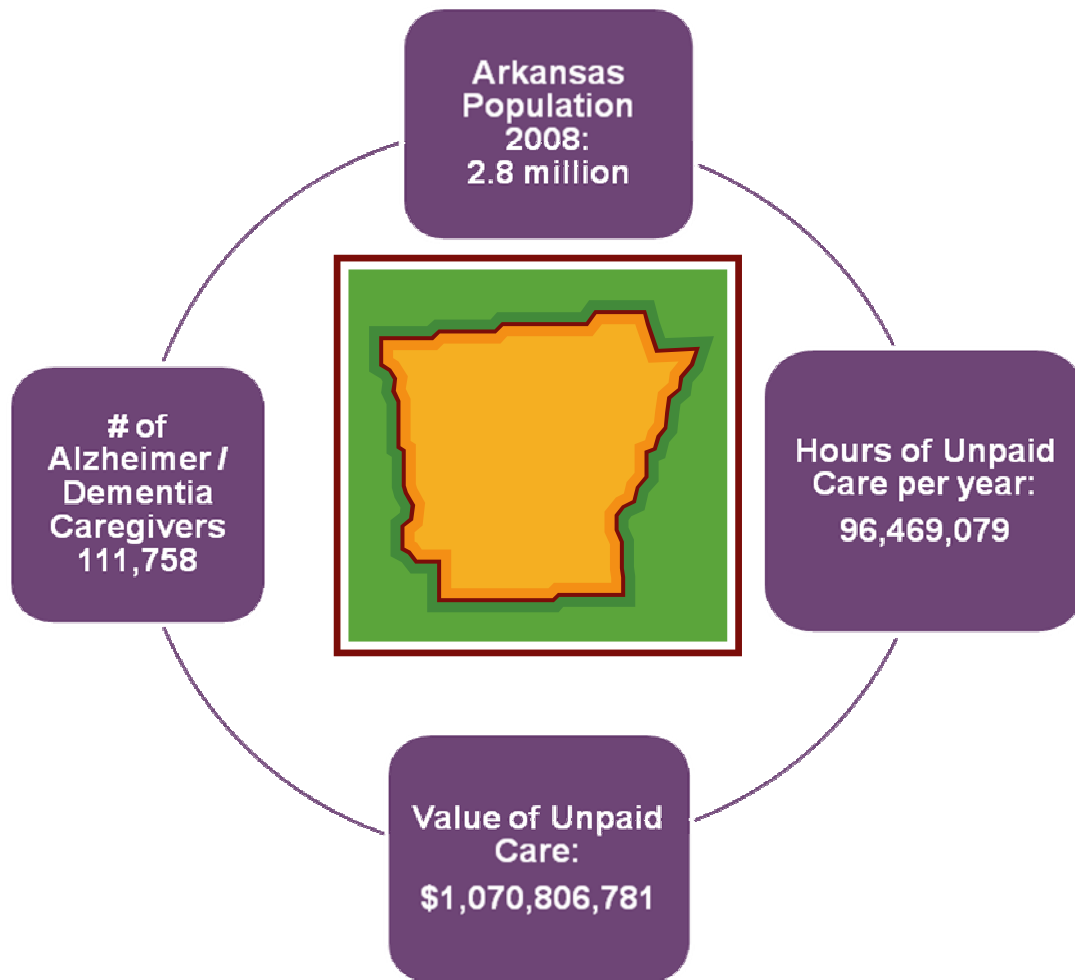
- Of family and unpaid caregivers of people with Alzheimer's or other dementias had caregiving related out-of-pocket expenditures that averaged \$219 a month
