Page 1, line 12 in the Title, add "OR POLICE" between "FIREMEN'S" and "PENSION";

AND

Page 1, line 16 in the Subtitle, add "AND POLICE" between "FIREFIGHTER" and "MEMBERS";

AND

Delete SECTION 1 of the bill and substitute a new SECTION 1 to the bill as follows:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-11-203(b) is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) The board shall be composed of nine (9) persons as follows:

(A) Two (2) fire fighters, either active or retired, one (1) of whom shall be appointed by the Governor from a list submitted by the Arkansas Council of Professional Fire Fighters and the other from a list submitted by the Arkansas State Fire Fighters Association;

(B) Two (2) police officers, either active or retired, to be appointed by the Governor, one (1) from a list submitted by the Arkansas Municipal Police Association and the other from a list submitted by the Fraternal Order of Police;

(C) Three (3) persons to be appointed by the Governor from a list submitted by the Arkansas Municipal League;

(D) One (1) person who is not a member, retirant, or beneficiary of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System and who is not a current or former member of the governing body of any political subdivision, to be appointed by the Governor from a list of persons submitted to him by the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs; and

(E) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration.

(2) The board shall elect one of its members as chairman.";

Page 1, delete lines 31 and 32 and substitute the following:

"(c) Board members appointed as employee members must be active or

retired members of local firemen's and";

AND

page 1, line 33, delete "of";

AND

Page 2, delete lines 3, 4, and 5 and substitute the following:

"(g)(1) In the event any employee board member ceases to be a an active or retired member of a local pension fund, or any employer board member ceases to be an".
