TO AMEND RULE 80 OF THE RULES OF THE
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Effective November 5, 2002, Rule 80 of the Rules of the House of Representatives is amended to read as follows:

The fourth caucus district shall be composed of the following House of Representatives districts: ~~83; 71; 49; 50; 19; 36; 38; 22; 18; 32; 48; 34; 74; 82; 100; 33; 75; 20; 28; 73; 37; 72; 35; 21; and 76~~ 1; 2; 3; 4; 5; 6; 7; 8; 9; 10; 11; 12; 16; 17; 18; 19; 20; 21; 22; 23; 24; 25; 26; 27; and 30.
